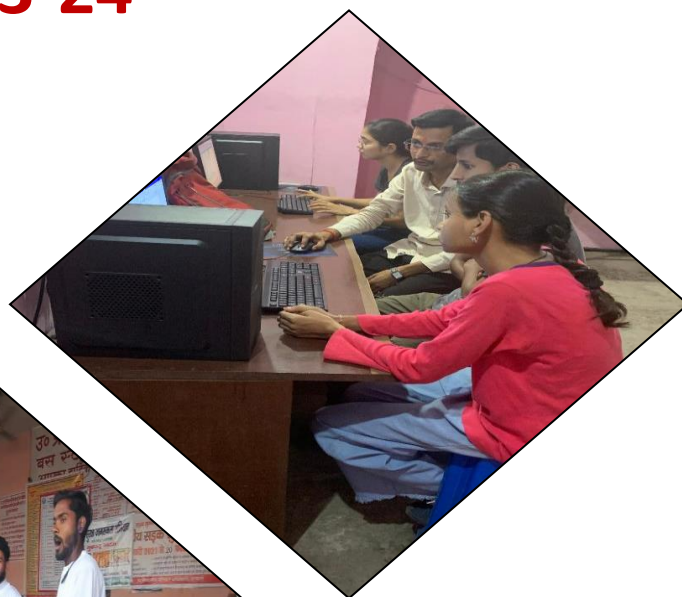

One of the important activities of the organization has been the promotion of handicraft that provides livelihood to a large number of people across the country particularly the people who are low educated but have skills to create beautiful things using their imaginary capacity and

need to be encouraged to come forward. This can be done only if carrying out such activities result in some economic benefits to these artists. Our organization provides raw materials to these artisans and gets the handicraft products ready and then sells them in the market using its own network and marketing system. We also try to place the students with the help of our supporters. It is a great source of inspiration for our organization to work towards the upliftment of society.

Another objective was to develop their skills and empower them for independent living. We created mass awareness on issues affecting them, such as, illegal liquor production, domestic violence, open defecation.

ART, HANDICRAFT AND VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM-:

Art is an important part of our lives that not only develops our aesthetic sense but also accompanies us in our loneliness. It helps us to describe our inner selves and instills in us a sense of satisfaction, appreciation and love for nature. We try to encourage youth to bring out their hidden talent by providing them, ways of expression through art and craft. We provide various short term courses. We also provide craft classes for children to engage them in productive activities during summer vacations. We believe in making learning fun and therefore practice the ways of teaching that children enjoy.

Society has also been running one training centre for handicraft work at the register office. In this centre, trainees were provided with the training in making Jute bags, wall hanging, baskets, chikan embroidery, etc. This training centre was organized by society in order to help those artistic people whose art is going in vain and they are not well placed in society. With the help of this training these people can stand on their own feet.

workshop indicated most adolescents gained knowledge on the changes in their body and felt happy about it.

We also train people in vocational courses. These courses help small artisans and low income group earn their living. The basic objective of this program is to provide the urban poor with proper vocational training so that they can undertake self-employment and increase their chances of employment in different sectors. People deprived of education can serve their family and themselves by getting self-employed.

Drug De-Addiction –:

To encourage street children and homeless youth to give up their drug habit and reduce risk behavior through a process of Detoxification, Rehabilitation and Mainstreaming. There are various causes and reasons why an individual gets addicted to drugs; it is necessary to identify the reason for one's addiction. Is it a way of coping with stress? Are you using it to get emotionally numb to avoid the physical or psychological pain you are bearing? Is alcohol being used as a means of avoiding responsibility? Is it due to peer pressure? It is essential to trace your cause of drug dependence. Mental health professionals at drug and alcohol de-addiction programs help identify the causes for treating them effectively by developing healthy coping styles. The outcome of a relationship with healthy boundaries is a survival mentality where the loved ones take up the responsibility to help cope with stress. These roles temporarily reduce the stress but also increase anxiety and confusion. Rehabilitation Centres help resolve these problems and establish healthy boundaries.



EMPOWERMENT OF WOMEN

There is no tool for development more effective than the empowerment of women.

AMC focuses on creating awareness and building capacity for women's political participation and collective action against social injustice and exploitation. Regular awareness sessions and group meetings with adolescent girls and women were conducted on reproductive health, safe motherhood, antenatal and postnatal care, breast feeding, nutrition, legal awareness, career counseling, life skills, self defense, menstrual hygiene, etc. They were also provided guidance in academic and personal development. Along with this young women were trained in vocational and life skills .

Ensuring Economic Empowerment

Financial Literacy sessions were initiated for adolescent girls as a step forward in ensuring their economic empowerment by making them aware of banking, investment, financial security, etc. and help them make informed choices in the future.

Capacity Building for Master Trainers

With community engagement at its core, field teams are the most important pillar . Focused capacity building sessions were held for the team on ground on relevant issues, to help them emerge as 'Master Trainers' in the community.



CAREER COUNSELLING

Every student is equipped with their own set of personal strengths and skills. The main aim of including the aspect of career counseling is to help students choose a field that is in tune with their skills and their job expectations and offer the right career guidance to the students. Career counseling has proved beneficial in terms of providing new directions to the students and boosting the confidence of the students. Students can now discuss in details about the new job trends, the variety of choices and make a more informed choice. Employees and management from various potential workplaces are engaged to give them live experience sharing sessions and a sneak peek into various career opportunities. A career counseling sessions is conducted by the experts.



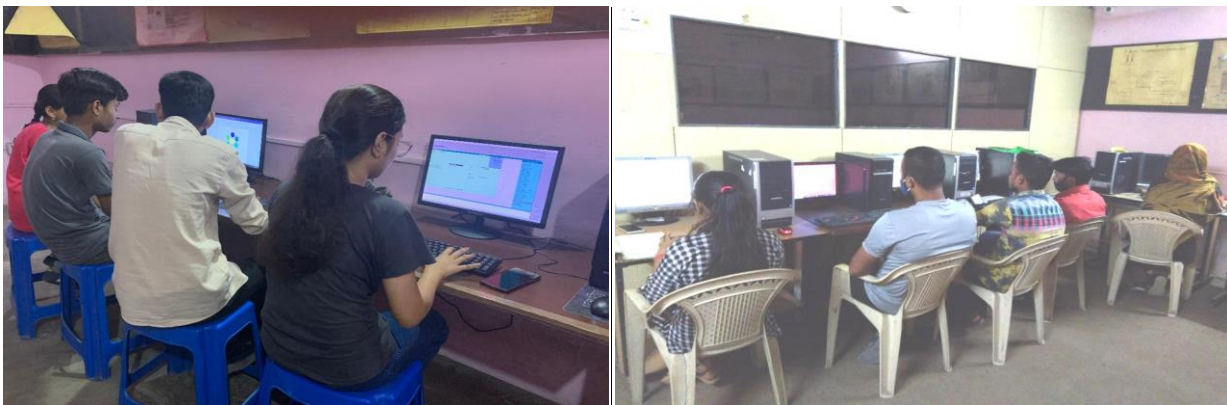
COMPUTER TRAINING PROGRAM-

Computers have become an integral part of today's lives. Computer technology or its usage is not confined to any one particular industry and its usage is in almost all the sectors/industries. Computer education became a part of the education system all over the world and people having computer knowledge are getting employment and jobs faster than the people without having it. These days, it is hard to find a job that does not involve a computer in some way.

Our mission is to spread computer education as wide as possible. Therefore we provide different computer training programs like Diploma courses in Professional DTP, CCC, Office Automation, Telle , Graphic Design, Information technology, etc. and other courses like Coral, Photoshop, Hardware, MS Office, etc. We train them to face the tough competition and become self-sustained.

There is great demand of computer trained professionals in town and other districts. Considering this demand, we have developed a Computer Education Project as part of a skills development initiative. AMC has identified the need for training in computers to the educated unemployed youth”.

We select the poor youth from rural villages, urban slums based on their family income, which should be low or below the poverty line to be eligible for this program. Every financial year we select 30 deserving poor youth to impart 6 months’ software training. The course syllabus includes Computer Fundamentals, MS Office, DTP, Internet Concepts and Soft Skills. We mainly concentrate on job oriented courses to create sustainable livelihood and employment opportunities. During the training, we provide study material to all the trainees free of cost. After completion of the computer course, certificates are awarded and course participants are placed in private and government sectors.



NATIONAL FESTIVALS:-

India is a land of multi-ethnicity where people of different languages and cultures live together with peace and harmony. We celebrate festivals like Independence Day, Republic Day to inculcate in People love for their Nation and bring unity among them.

Students prepare different programs like short plays, Patriotic songs and dances, speeches, etc. By organizing such competitions we encourage students to participate in celebration of these festivals and arouse feelings of nationalism in them.



ROAD SAFETY :-

Road and transport is an integral part of our life. Along with conveniences, it brings travelers lots of risks if not proper road safety education is provided. Therefore, it is very important to educate the people about traffic rules and thus special workshops are held at AMC in order to appraise them of road safety rules and staggering statistics of ill-fated deaths through ignorance of such rules. In this program Mr. Mohsin Khan said, "Let us not become our own enemies on the road but work together to develop our knowledge and attitude as our road infrastructure improves". He added, "It's our duty to reduce road casualties to as close to zero as possible. On this occasion AMC volunteers raised awareness about road safety among the people on the roads and streets.

HYGIENE AND SANITATION PROJECTS -:

Personal hygiene education is one of the most powerful barriers to stopping the spread of diseases that can be carried through the water. Hands are the main vessel for carrying bacteria, so teaching a simple, yet effective, hand-washing practice, using clean water and soap, if possible, is essential. Additionally, teaching the dangers of open defecation can reduce, and even eliminate, the spread of pandemic waterborne diseases (such as cholera).. Good hygiene practices help ensure people are healthy.

Through home and environment hygiene training, AMC helps families to gain an awareness of the risks that human water pollution causes, and it teaches families how to proactively reduce pollution by taking preventative measures, such as keeping the surroundings around their homes, schools, and fields clean. The training also includes the proper construction, use, and maintenance of sanitation facilities, which further prevents dangerous water contamination.

With no awareness of or access to proper health care facilities, the ultra-poor do not have the privilege of preventive health care. the programme guides them towards a healthy lifestyle.
